

## DASH REMOVAL INSTRUCTION FOR 2005-UP CORVETTE

Many Corvette owners purchase auxiliary input adapters and iPod adapters from us that require dash disassemble. We thought it would make sense to add these dash removal instructions for those wanting to do their own installs. So here it is.

### Tools Required:

Socket Wrench with 7mm socket  
Flat Screwdriver  
Phillips Screwdriver  
T-15/T-25 Torx driver

**1. Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.  
Open armrest and remove (4) T15 Torx screws.**

**2. Unclip and remove ride control switch/blank plate at front edge of center console lid. (use a small screwdriver to pry upwards)**  
**(Figure A)**

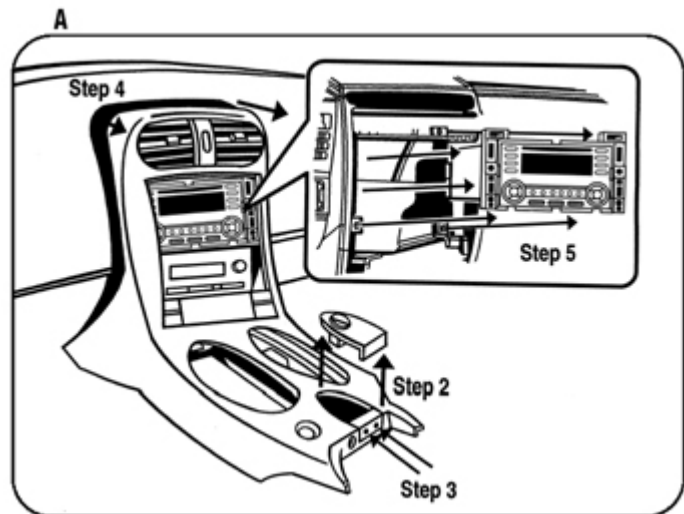
**3. Remove (2) 9/32" (7mm) screws from under plate removed in step 2.**  
**(Figure A)**

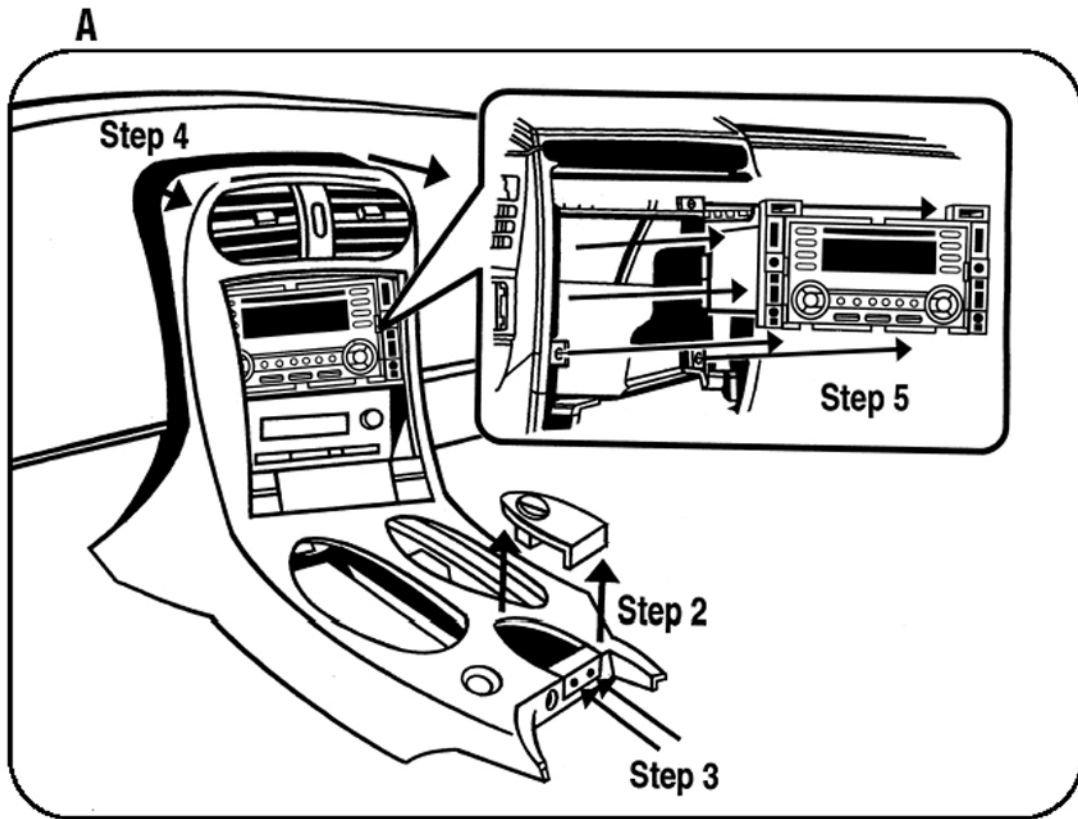
**Pull emergency brake boot upwards until it disconnects.  
Remove two 7mm bolts at the right side of the console. Accessible after lifting brake boot. Remove shift knob by pulling down on shift boot and removing screw.**

**4. Unclip and remove entire panel surrounding radio and including a/c controls. Pull outwards.** **(Figure A)**

**5. Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing radio and (2) 9/32 screws securing the AC controls to extract from sub dash.**  
**(Figure A)**

**6. Disconnect electrical connectors**





With the radio out, proceed with instructions provided with the auxiliary input adapter, iPod adapter etc.
