PXDP-C5

Quick Start iPod Adapter Install Guide for select 1997-04 Corvette

Introduction:

Many Corvette Owners looking to connect and play Apple iPod device to the factory radio will be pleased to find the PXDP-C5. This adapter allows users to play and charge their Apple iPod and control select functions from the radio buttons. The PXDP-C5 uses the changer port on radio so any 12-disc changer in trunk or hatch must be disconnecting.

The PXDP-C5 connects at the radio or 10-pin CD changer plug in trunk or hatch in **1997-04 Corvette C5** and **requires disconnected the 12-disc changer**, but with the storage capacity of most Apple iPod devices, sacrificing the CD changer should be an easy decision.

Installation: (To radio)

Remove radio from dashboard to gain access to the connectors. (*Click link below for radio removal instruction video*)

1. Disconnect factory 20-pin plug from radio (See **Fig. 1**)

2. Connect 20-pin plug (gray/black) from installation harness (See **Fig. 2**) to radio 20-pin port vacated in step 1

3. Connect factory 20-pin plug (black/gray) to installation harness 20-pin (white) connector
4. Ensure module dip-switches #3 and #8 are set to "ON" (See **Fig. 3**)



5. Connect installation harness 22-pin plug (See **Fig. 2**) to mating connector on Module
6. Connect dock cable 8-pin plug to Module 8-pin connector (See **Fig. 3**)
7. Route 30-pin dock (See **Fig. 4**) to front of the dash or location where audio device will reside (within 10 ft.)

Test Operation:

1. Turn ignition and radio "ON"
2. Press "TAPE/AUX" OR "CD/AUX" button on radio to enter AUX mode
3. Connect audio device to dock connector (See Fig. 4)
4. Initiate playback on audio device.
5. Use radio volume control button to set playback level. Set audio device volume level to 80% or more. IF distorted, reduce slightly.

Warning! Playlist and Track selection is *NOT* possible from the GM radio. You must use the audio devices built-in controls to access audio files.



Frequent asked questions

1. **Does the PXDP-C5 work on other Corvette radios**
NO; Works on 1997-04 Corvette AM/FM/Tape and AM/FM/CD Radios with TAPE/AUX or CD/AUX button
2. **Can I use the radio buttons to control the Apple device**
YES; The PXDP-C5 adapter is capable of controlling four basic Apple device functions using the radio buttons including FF, REW, track up and track down and of course volume.
3. **Can I use the radio buttons to navigate Apple device menu?**
NO; this adapter is not capable of browsing apple menus (i.e. Search by Artist, Song, and Playlist etc.). You must use the Apple device built-in controls to navigate its menus.
4. **In addition to my iPod I also have an Android. What if anything is available for me to play music from my Android phone?**
 Purchase our [A2D-DOCK](#) (wireless) or [3.5-PODF](#) (wired) (See Fig. 5) add-ons. Both connects to the 30-pin dock to allow music streaming via Bluetooth or hard-wired via headphone jack.
